How to Play



1. Teach your students about [the five events](#) of Israel History Month using the videos for each event. Once you have engaged your students in the material, at the end of Israel History Month, use this in-class Bingo game as a fun way to assess what they learned. Everything included in this game is covered in the videos for the five events.
2. Print out the Bingo boards below so each student gets one board. Each Bingo board has the same answers, but they are arranged differently on all the boards.
3. Read questions and prompts provided in the following page. Ask your students to answer the questions as you read them, choosing from the answers provided in the Bingo squares using NO notes or resources. Students should mark the square that has the “answer” as they complete it.
4. For open-ended questions, students should write their answer, and then mark ONE “open-ended question space” complete. The middle square is a free space.
5. Students should call Bingo when they complete five squares in a row, column or diagonal. Verify the boards to make sure they are correct.
6. After students call Bingo, continue playing until all questions are read and students complete all 24 squares on the Board.
7. Give the winners and each student a prize!
